Funeral services for Mrs. Bessie Elizabeth Norris Johnson, 93, who died peacefully on Sunday, April 30, 2017, will be held at Noon on Friday, May 5, 2017, at Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church. She raised her children in Hartsville and worked at Emmanuel Baptist School for 26 years as a Fourth Grade teacher. She retired in the early 90's and continued to volunteer with the school until 2008. She and her husband continued to be actively involved at Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church where she enjoyed singing in the choir. She enjoyed serving her Lord, which was her number one priority in her life. She loved people and would go out of her way to serve others, to meet their needs, and to help them. She truly enjoyed a full life well lived.
