



Mr. Charles John Bartel

August 19, 1949 - June 24, 2019

On Monday, June 24, 2019, Charles John "Bart" Bartel, loving husband, father and grandfather died at the age of 69. Charles was born in Chicago, IL to Fred and Alleen Rogers Bartel. He served in the United States Air Force from 1968 to 1972. He was awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal for assisting Secret Service communications efforts related to protective support of the 1972 presidential candidates. Charles married Alexa Cloyd on May 14, 1972, and they raised two children, Amy-Lynn and Jonathen. In 1981 he graduated from Appalachian State University with a BS in Industrial Arts Education. He taught electronics to high school and community college students for over 25 years. Charles was honored as a 1996 recipient of the President's Awards for Excellence in Instruction from Ivy Tech Community College, Bloomington, Indiana.

Charles loved fishing the many lakes and ponds around Hartsville. He was a member of the Hartsville Woodworkers and enjoyed making wooden toys and pet treat jars. Proceeds from the sale of the toys and jars were donated to the Darlington County Humane Society. He also volunteered at their store, Re-Tail Therapy Resale. Charles loved driving through the countryside in his beloved 1996 Mazda Miata.

Charles is survived by his wife, Alexa; his two children, Amy-Lynn Bartel Albertson and Jonathen Rogers Bartel; and three granddaughters, Jaymes, Jayden and Faith. He was preceded in death by his father, Fred; his mother, Alleen; and his brother, Roger.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated on Friday, June 28, 2019, at St. Mary the Virgin Mother Catholic Church at 10:00 a.m. The rosary will be recited at 9:30 a.m. in the chapel. Visitation will be held on Saturday, June 29, 2019, from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. at 520 West College Avenue.
