Funeral services for George Thomas Rogers, 61, will be held at 11 am Tuesday, March 11, 2014 at Willow Oaks Farm, 4748 Hartsville Highway, Society Hill, SC 29593. George, husband of Lyrae Creamer Rogers, died Saturday, March 8th, 2014. Born in Hartsville, SC, he was the son of Anna Gillespie Rogers and the late Paul Hamilton Rogers IV. George graduated NC State with a mechanical engineering degree and went on to own his own business building custom fabricated machines for over 30 years, beginning in 1983.
