



Mrs. Allene Stuckey Reep

February 17, 1933 - August 2, 2014

Allene Stuckey Reep, teacher, librarian, and avid gardener, died on Saturday, August 2, 2014 at age 81. Memorial services will be held at 3:15 p.m. on Saturday, August 9, 2014 at Our Shepherd Lutheran Church. The family will receive friends from 2:00 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. prior to the service at the church. Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home is serving the family.

She was born in Hartsville on February 17, 1933, to Cleon Carson Stuckey and Allene Hanna Stuckey and was one of five children. She was Valedictorian of the Hartsville High School Class of 1951 and graduated from Coker College in 1955.

In 1956, she married Lewis Jones Reep of Lincolnton, NC and they made a home in Hartsville.

Over the years she taught in Hartsville Public Schools and Thomas Hart Academy before becoming the Librarian at the Hartsville Memorial Library. Allene was involved in a number of activities including support for Coker College, Kalmia Gardens and Thomas Hart.

She loved travel and was a member of the Florence chapter of The Friendship Force, hosting a number of individuals from across the globe to her home. She also traveled with the group to New Zealand and to England.

She is survived by her husband, Lewis Reep of Hartsville, SC, and their daughters, Lucy Reep (Andrew C. Foster) of Ponte Vedra Beach, FL; Chandler Reep Darling (Alan Darling) of Greenwood, SC; Rebecca Reep Lisy (Mark Lisy) of Charlotte, NC; grandchildren, Dylan Foster, Carson Foster, Benjamin Darling, Daniel Darling, Luke Darling, Cameron Lisy, Connor Lisy; siblings, Mary Stuckey Byrd, Jim Stuckey, and twin sister, Alice Stuckey Thomas. She was preceded in death by her sister, Margaret Stuckey Nolan.
