



Mrs. Anne Jordan Rider

It is with deep sorrow that the Rider family announces the death of their beloved mother, Mrs. Anne Jordan Rider, 88.

Mrs. Rider, the widow of George McKinne Rider, entered into rest on Monday, July 3, 2023. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.

A graveside service to honor her life will be held at 10:30 am on Saturday, July 8, 2023, in Magnolia Cemetery, conducted by her former pastor, The Rev. David McIntosh. The public is invited to join Anne's family and celebrate God's mercy, love, and grace to one of his children.

She was born in Hartsville on October 22, 1934, to Carroll T. and Lillian B. Jordan. She was a graduate of Hartsville High School and received a BA from Columbia College and an MA from the University of South Carolina.

Anne married George Mckinne Rider on June 3, 1956. In 1961, they left the States with three small children for Africa, where George worked with a non-government organization (NGO). The family was transferred to Europe in 1967, and Anne helped her husband in the NGO. When in the States between overseas assignments, Anne taught school and Sunday school. The couple retired in 1998 and returned to Hartsville.

Anne was preceded in death by her husband of sixty-four years, three grandsons, Emmanuel Rider, Alexander Rider, and Jeffrey Grubbs; brothers, Carroll Thomas Jordan, Jr., Sidney Albert Jordan, Sr., Ennis Barfield Jordan, Joseph Hopkins Jordan; sister, Sarah Jordan Matthews.

She is survived by her children, Scott and Sarah Grubbs, Kinne and Lucille Rider, William Rider, Claude and Carol Grunenwald, Tim and Amy Rider; twelve grandchildren, ten great-grandchildren; and one sister, Grace Jordan Hamrick.
