



## Mr. Anthony Rudolph Floyd Jr.

February 21, 1942 - September 3, 2025

The family of Anthony R. Floyd, Jr. announces the death of their beloved husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather.

Mr. Floyd passed peacefully in his sleep on Wednesday, September 3, 2025. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.

A funeral service to honor his life will be held at 3 o'clock on Saturday, September 6, 2025, at First Baptist Church in Hartsville, South Carolina, with burial in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends immediately following the service.

Mr. Floyd was born on February 21, 1942, in Estill, South Carolina. He is the son of the late Anthony R. Floyd, Sr., and Myrtis Irene Hutto Floyd.

Anthony was a hardworking family man who devoted his life to his family and his successful career as the owner of Hixson Paint and Body Shop in Hartsville, South Carolina. He loved music and the arts. In his early years, he devoted himself to the study and performance of music and voice at Coker University, led and participated in many church and community choirs, and introduced his family to the wonders of music at an early age. He served as a deacon for many years at First Baptist Church in Hartsville.

His main devotion was to his wife, Jacquelyn H. Floyd. They met at Dreher High School in Columbia and spent their lives in Hartsville, South Carolina. In addition to his wife, he is survived by his son, Tony Floyd (Terry) of Mars Hill, North Carolina; daughter, Tina Bailey (Mark) of Blowing Rock, North Carolina. Anthony is also survived by grandchildren, Olivia Floyd Glowka, Sarah Floyd Stuckey, and great-grandchildren, Lucy Stuckey, Thurston Stuckey, and soon to be born on September 21, Weston Anthony Glowka.

Mr. Floyd was preceded in death by his brother, J. Daniel Floyd of Charleston, South Carolina.
