



## Mrs. Barbara Funderburk Johnson

November 2, 1941 - December 12, 2023

Cynthia and her husband, Eddie Smith, gave Pee Dee and Barbara three granddaughters: April, Jennifer, and Magan. Bobby loved all her girls with her whole heart. As the matriarch of her family, she was known for hosting family dinners and was used to hearing, "Hey Ma Ma, what are you cooking today?" from all her grandkids. She became a "Ma Ma" to many kids throughout the years, But she was also blessed with four great-grandchildren. She would always say she was biased, but those four kids were the most beautiful children God had ever put on this planet. Blazlea, Avery, Abby, and Cooper held a special place in her heart, and she would light up every time she saw them.

Bobby was a woman who loved God and her family, but she was so much more than that; she was funny with her comebacks, and she was loyal, strong, and tough! She was our rock! 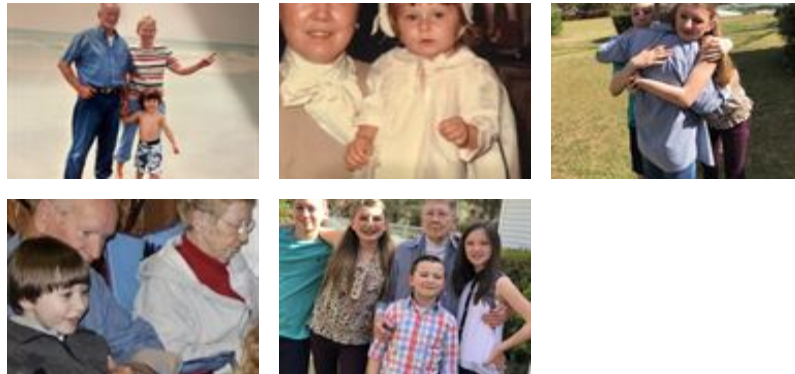
