



Barbara Ella Davis Yarborough

October 15, 1935 - November 25, 2008

Barbara Ella Davis Yarborough, member of the Brevard Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, died of Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (Lou Gehrig's disease) 25 Nov 2008 at the home of her son in Mount Airy, North Carolina.

Born on 15 Oct 1935 in Cordova, NC, she was one of five children of the late Robert Benjamin and Edith Mae Goude Davis. She was raised in Cheraw, SC and lived in Hartsville, SC until she moved to Brevard in 1973 where she remained for 30 years until moving to live with her son and his family in Colorado.

She worked as a radio dispatcher for the Cheraw Police Department and later as a copyeditor for the Hartsville Messenger. After moving to Brevard she worked for Omega Music, as manager for the Triangle Stop and then as a department manager for Wal-Mart. She was also active in the Church and served as a teacher for the Youth Activities.

Barbara was preceded by her husband of over 50 years, Robert (Bobby) Claude Yarborough who died in 2003; her brothers Francis Wesley Davis, 2000 and Marvin Alvester Davis, 2008, Jefferson Davis, 2008.

Survivors include two children, Teresa Ann King of Raleigh, NC and Lt Col Robert T. Yarborough of Mount Airy, NC; a brother Robert Alton Davis of Cheraw, SC; a sister Dora Juanita Davis West of Dunn, NC; and seven grandchildren.
