



## Mr. Baxter Ray Ewing

February 2, 1951 - September 15, 2011

Funeral services for Baxter Ray Ewing, 60, will be held at 4:00 p.m. Saturday, September 17, 2011 at Lakeview Baptist Church. The Rev. Dr. Tim McKnight will officiate with entombment at Westview Memorial Park Cemetery. The family will receive friends Friday, September 16, 2011 from 5-7 p.m. at Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home. Mr. Ewing died Thursday, September 15, 2011. Born in Darlington Co., SC, he was a son of Virginia Byrd Ewing and the late Clarence Ewing. He was a member of Lakeview Baptist Church where he served as a Sunday School teacher, deacon, Cub Scout leader, and RA leader. He graduated from Florence-Darlington Technical College summa cum laude with a degree in Engineering Graphics. He was previously employed with the Darlington County Correctional Institute and Gayley & Lord. He enjoyed participating in marathons and cycling.
