Born in Columbia, SC, he was a son of the late Marcellus Seabrook and Edna Reed Whaley. He was a member of St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church, where he served on the Vestry and as Senior Warden. He was also very active in the Kairos Prison Ministry.

He graduated with honors from the University of South Carolina with a B. S. in Chemical Engineering, first worked at Firestone as a research chemist, was retired from Sonoco Products Company as a research chemist, and was a past president of the American Chemical Society. He was a Paul Harris Fellow in the Hartsville Rotary Club and established several student scholarships at Coker College.
