He was born on March 23, 1954, in Sumter, SC, to his beloved parents, William Hamer and Charlotte Ryan Stuckey. In addition to his beloved wife, he is survived by his sons, Brooks Ryan, Jr (Aly) and Marshall Walden (Kathryn) and his most precious grandchildren who called him Granddaddy: James Payne, George Salter and Charlotte Wright Stuckey.
