



## Mr. Bud J. Lindler

February 4, 1931 - August 4, 2019

Graveside funeral services for Mr. Bud J. Lindler, 88, will be held at 3 o'clock on Wednesday, August 7, 2019, in Magnolia Cemetery. The Rev. Mr. Lindler died on Sunday, August 4, 2019. He was born in Saluda, SC, a son of the late Joseph S. and Mae Ridgell Lindler. Bud graduated from Saluda High School and received a Bachelor and Masters Degree in Agriculture from Clemson College. He was a veteran of the United States Air Force during the Korean Conflict. Bud retired after 38 years with the National Cotton Council where he was the regional manager for the Southeastern area for membership services. Bud also served as a special representative to the US textile industry.

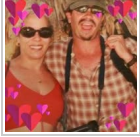
