



## Carol Coggeshall

August 15, 1944 - June 26, 2010

Funeral services for Carol Harvey Coggeshall, 65, will be held at 11:00 a.m. Tuesday, June 29, 2010 at the First Presbyterian Church. The Rev. Dr. Jeri Parris Perkins will officiate with a private burial in Magnolia Cemetery directed by Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home. Mrs. Coggeshall died Saturday, June 26, 2010. Born in Wichita Falls, TX, she was a daughter of the late Chester Lawrence and Thelma Jean Armstrong Harvey. Her father was killed in a military airplane crash prior to her birth and she was lovingly raised by her mother and stepfather, Col. Robert Craven Drum. Growing up she lived in New Hampshire, New York, Tennessee, Virginia, Kansas, Hawaii and Panama. She graduated from Queens College in Charlotte, NC in 1966 with an AB degree in English Literature. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Hartsville and the Spring Beauty Garden Club. Over the years she was an active volunteer in a number of church, educational and civic organizations, and in 1991 she received a special recognition from the SC Board of Education for her significant contributions to the public schools.

Mrs. Coggeshall is survived by her husband of 43 years, Peter Collin Coggeshall, Jr. of Hartsville, who she married in Topeka, KS in 1967; son and daughter-in-law, Collin Drum and Melissa Hayes Coggeshall of Daniel Island,

SC; grandsons, Peter Hayes Coggeshall and Weston Howard Coggeshall, also of Daniel Island; sisters, Linda Harvey Ireland of Memphis, TN, Deborah Drum (Ward) Holliday of Dallas, TX.
