It is with deep sorrow that we announce the death of Mrs. Carolyn Moore Hall, 86.

Mrs. Hall, the widow of Joseph Jackson "Jack" Hall, entered into rest on Friday, April 11, 2025. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.

A graveside funeral service to honor her life will be held at 1 o'clock on Wednesday, April 16, 2025, in Union Methodist Church Cemetery, with The Rev. Charlie Short officiating. The family will receive friends immediately following the service.

Carolyn Marie Moore was born in Darlington County on September 26, 1938, to the late James Drew and Bessie McCoy Moore. She grew up on the Chesterfield Darlington county farm in a small four-room home with an outhouse. They were close and enjoyed the company of all the cousins and family nearby.

She went to schools in McBee, graduating from high school in 1956 and going on to Coker College to graduate with a Business Degree in 1961. Her first job was at Byerly Hospital (now Carolina Pines) in Hartsville. She was very proud that she bought the first Ford Mustang in McBee with money she had saved

and carried to the dealership in a sock. She recalled that Mr. Newome said he had never seen anyone buy a car with “sock” money.

In October of 1967, she married Jack Hall, whom she had met on a blind date. They did not have any children, only small toy dogs over the years. She served in the Office of Procurement at the Naval base where Jack was stationed in Norfolk, Virginia, until moving to Charlotte, NC, in the 1970s. There, she began an 18-year career as a bookkeeper for the Charlotte Douglas Airport, until she retired.

She enjoyed traveling, being out in her yard, going to plays, the beauty salon, and going out to eat. After she became a widow, she enjoyed the close-knit cul-de-sac friends of her street.

Although her death was unexpected and sudden, we are hopeful that she is enjoying the peace she has been longing for.

She is survived by her niece, Karen Moore ten Bensel (Wade), and her nephew, Robert Moore (Nicolette).
