Mrs. Griggs died Thursday, October 30, 2008. Born in Darlington Co., SC, she was a daughter of the late William Manuel and Mary Edwards Langley. She was retired with 28 years of service from the Housing Authority of Hartsville, 22 of those years she served as Executive Director. As Executive Director she received certificates of excellence in management operations and secretary commendations for high performance. She served on the Housing and Urban Development Regional Advisory Council for Public Housing.

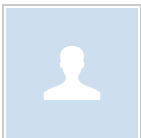
