



Rev. Charles Hazel Nicholson, Jr.

Funeral services for The Rev. Charles Hazel Nicholson, Jr., 84, who died peacefully on Saturday, May 7, 2016, will be held at 2 o'clock on Monday, May 9, 2016 in The Chapel at Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home. The Rev. He enlisted in the United States Army at age 17 and spent a little over 3 years in Germany in the First Division Signal Corps. Before developing Alzheimer's disease, Charles was an avid reader who studied the Bible, worked crossword puzzles daily, followed the Atlanta Braves baseball team tirelessly, and was always quick-witted. His family rejoices knowing that his physical ailments have been healed and he is at peace.

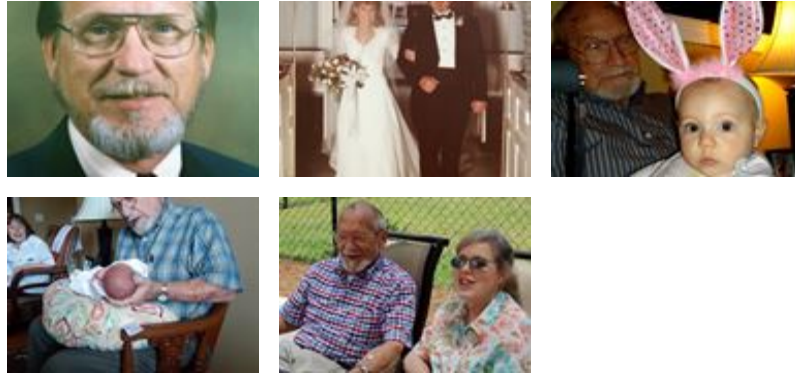

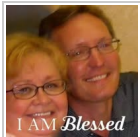
