



Mr. Charlie Wayne Jordan

November 8, 1958 - September 18, 2025

With deep sorrow, Ms. Jessi Jordan Sadaka and her family announce the death of her beloved father, Mr. Charlie Wayne Jordan, age 66.

Charlie passed away peacefully on Thursday, September 18, 2025. A funeral service to honor his life will be held at 11 o'clock on Monday, September 22, 2025, in the Chapel of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home, with The Rev. Lin Kirkman presiding. The family will receive friends immediately following the service, then proceed to Magnolia Cemetery for a private burial.

Charlie Jordan was born November 8, 1958, at Shaw AFB in Sumter County, South Carolina. He was the middle son of the late Joseph Leslie Jordan, Sr. and the late Betty Carolyn Stokes Jordan.

During Charlie's early life, he lived and attended schools around the world, as his family followed his father's United States Air Force career. He graduated from Francis Marion College, moved to the Washington, DC area, and enjoyed a successful career in computer technology. He and two good friends became founding partners of a software design business together.

Later, Charlie returned to South Carolina to care for his parents in their final years. He then remained a proud resident of Hartsville, where he commonly frequented the local YMCA to swim, exercise, and socialize with local friends.

Throughout his life, Charlie was an avid reader of the science fiction, fantasy, and historical fiction genres. He was also a history buff, paying particular attention to the World War II period, Ancient Rome, and naval/maritime history. He enjoyed playing board and computer games, often in multiplayer with his friends and family.

Charlie is survived by one child, Jessi Jordan Sadaka of Columbus, OH, and by his two brothers: Joseph Leslie Jordan, Jr. of Glen Burie, MD and John Barry Jordan of Las Vegas, NV. They remember him with love, and they were honored to spend his final days together with him.
