David and Claudia spent their retirement years on the beautiful Monterey Coast, an area reminiscent of the Italian Coast that they dearly loved. David is survived by his two daughters, Laura Lane-Williams (Takashi Kato) of Hereford, AZ, and Sherry Lane of Marina, CA.
