Funeral services for Deborah Lynn Walters, PhD, 59, who died peacefully on Thursday, April 2, 2015, will be held at 3 o'clock on Saturday, April 4, 2015 in the Chapel of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home. Born in Hartsville, SC, she was a daughter of William "Bill" Walters of Lugoff, SC, and the Late Betty Marshall Walters.

Deb Walters was not only a wonderful person and mother, but also a brilliant teacher that touched thousands of lives in her over thirty years of teaching. She loved her students and loved to make a difference for them. In her time as an educator, she touched the lives and minds of so many young people. She decided to go back to school to further her education at the University of South Carolina. She accomplished her dream, a PhD, through hard work and dedication, driving to Columbia multiple times a week for years while balancing a full time job and mothering her beloved daughter.

Deb believed in the power of education, and did not accept failure. It was her dream to change as many children's lives as possible for the better. More

often than not the classes she taught were children struggling with learning disorders, hard home lives, and basic reading skills. She loved each and everyone of her students, past and present, regardless of their behavior, race, or creed. Deb truly believed that children are our future. She strongly believed in her them and would not accept anything less than them coming into their full potential while in her classroom. She was awarded Teacher of the Year multiple times over the years, proving that not only did she love her students, but they loved her too.

She was incredibly headstrong. When she decided to do something, she went ahead and did it, from last minute getaways to Oak Island, NC, her favorite place in the world, to visiting her daughter and her grand-puppy in Columbia, to random shopping trips just because. She loved her Jeep Wrangler, being outside for any reason, especially at the beach, and above all else, her daughter.

She was spontaneous, full of joy and life, and never met a stranger. She always had a beautiful smile on her face. She taught her daughter to be strong, self reliable, and independent, just like her. She was taken far too soon, but now can rest in peace and watch over us all. She will be so greatly missed by everyone who loved her.

She is survived by her loving daughter, Kaci Rae King of Lexington, SC; brother, Hugh Walters of Atlanta, GA; sister, Cindy Walters of Hartsville, SC; Kaci's father, Harry King of Hartsville, SC. She was preceded in death by her mother, Betty Marshall Walters; brother, Bill Walters, Jr.
