



Deward Brittain

Funeral services for Deward Belmont Brittain, 89, will be held at 10:00 a.m. Thursday, August 26, 2010 at St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church Memory Garden. Fr. Michael Ridgill will officiate and Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home is serving the family. Mr. Brittain died Tuesday, August 24, 2010. Born in Spartanburg Co., SC, he was a son of the late Vaughan DeWitt and Elizabeth Ramsey Brittain. Deward was a graduate of the University of South Carolina and served during World War II as a naval officer in the Pacific. He was Managing Editor of the Rock Hill Evening Herald from 1946-1953. He retired from Owens-Illinois in 1978 and also retired as President of Palmetto Packaging Corp. in 1990. He was a member and former Senior Warden of St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church. He was a former member of the Coker College Board of Trustees, the Board of Trustees of the Episcopal Church Home for Children in York, and the Still Hopes Retirement Home in Columbia.

Surviving is his wife, Sloan Hungerpiller Brittain of Hartsville, SC.
