



## Mr. Dominick T. "Charles" Trifiletti

August 20, 1916 - July 12, 2011

Dominick T. "Charles" Trifiletti, 94, a longtime resident of Florence, South Carolina, died Tuesday, July 12, 2011, at McLeod Regional Medical Center in Florence. Mr. Trifiletti was born August 20, 1916, in Mamaroneck, New York, in Westchester County, and was a son of the late Joseph T. Trifiletti and Elizabeth Saverese Trifiletti. He was predeceased by his first wife Alma Bailey Trifiletti of Latta, South Carolina, and his second wife Laura Lowry Trifiletti of Jefferson, South Carolina.

Surviving are his son Joseph G. Trifiletti (Marty Piepenbring) of Pawley's Island, South Carolina; his granddaughter, Elizabeth Trifiletti Johnson (Jed) and his great-grandson, Miller Lee Johnson of Charlotte, North Carolina; two sisters, Helen (George) Pooley of Stewart, FL and Lillian (John) Sejkowsky of Thousand Oaks, CA; a sister-in-law, Jacqueline L. Caudill of Durham, North Carolina, and a number of nieces and nephews.

Mr. Trifiletti graduated from Effie Bellows High School in 1936 and from the University of South Carolina in 1953 with a B.S. in Business Administration. He was employed by the U.S. Treasury Department for thirty-one years serving as an Internal Revenue Service field agent. He also taught business courses at Florence-Darlington Technical College for twenty-two years. Mr. Trifiletti was a veteran of WWII and the Korean War. He was also a member of First Presbyterian Church of Florence. He served a number of years as

the Cub Master for Pack 416 at Calvary Baptist Church and worked with the Boy Scouts in the Pee Dee Area Council, where he earned a certificate for completing the Training Recognition Plan for the Scouter's Key.

Visitation will be held at the First Presbyterian Church of Florence, Lawson-Rain Chapel on Friday, July 15th from 5 - 6:30 P.M. Graveside services will be held at the Miller-Lowry Cemetery in Jefferson, South Carolina, Saturday, July 16th at 1 P.M.
