



## Mrs. Doris Truett Winburn

July 5, 1929 - December 20, 2023

Doris Truett Winburn, widow of Allen Kenneth Winburn, died on December 20, 2023, at her home.

Born on July 5, 1929, in Darlington, SC, Doris was the daughter of the late Edward Roston and Eva Knotts Truett. She was the youngest of 6 children and graduated from St. John's High School in Darlington at age 15. She married Kenneth in 1950 and moved to Hartsville. She was a faithful member of First Baptist Church Hartsville for over 70 years where she served in the children's Sunday School class for many years and on many other church committees. Her mission circle group and Sunday School friends were very dear to her. She proudly helped orchestrate and served on the annual Christmas mission bazaar team and was always so happy with the money raised to give to foreign missions. Doris was faithful to her Lord and Savior throughout her life and set an example to her family. She was sure to have her family in church if the doors were open. Her favorite Bible verse was Philippians 4:13 "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." She also enjoyed her bowling team of which she was a part until 89 years old. She was a volunteer in the Carolina Pines Regional Medical Center's gift shop for more than twenty years.

Doris worked as an executive administrative assistant at Sonoco until her retirement. She enjoyed her job and made many close friends. After

retirement, she became the personal assistant to Mr. and Mrs. Richard Coker. This grew into a wonderful bond and lasting friendship. They became family to her.

Doris enjoyed traveling the United States and the world with her high school friends, Ed and Christine Hursey, Clara Hinds, and Belva Lynn Comba. They created memories and stories about which we all enjoyed hearing and laughing.

Surviving are her daughter, Robin Winburn Atkins and her son-in-law George Tomlinson Atkins, Sr. with whom she shared a very special relationship and was loved as her son; and her daughter-in-law, Kim Brown Winburn.
