Dorothy Ann Adams went to Our Lord on Saturday, February 22, 2014. She was a resident of the Presbyterian Retirement Community in Florence, SC, where she moved in 2006 from her home in Hartsville, SC. While in Hartsville, Mrs. Adams was a member of the Thursday Study Club, the 2nd oldest Ladies Club in SC and the Spring Beauty Garden Club. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Hartsville. Mrs. Adams's funeral service will be held in the Retirement Community Chapel at 2 p.m. on Friday, February 28, 2014. The family will receive friends following the service. A private burial will be held in Magnolia Cemetery.

Surviving are her son-in-law, Ronald Joe Turner, and grandson, Daniel McColman Turner.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Hal M. Adams; daughter, Dianne Turner; son, Hal M. Adams, Jr.
