



Dot Teal Hendrix

June 16, 1923 - May 25, 2010

Sara Dot Teal Hendrix, 86, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, May 26th, 2010. She was born June 16th, 1923, to the late William Archibald and Susanna Hawkins Teal. Dot graduated from Lander College in 1944 with a Bachelor of Arts degree. While at Lander, she was a member of the Glee Club singing soprano and sang at various functions. She also played the piano for the Glee Club. She earned graduate hours from the University of South Carolina. She taught in the public schools system for over 30 years. She was the organist/pianist at Bethlehem United Methodist Church for over 65 years. Dot was also a dedicated choir director for her church and she played the organ or piano for numerous weddings and funerals. She had a touch on the piano that will never be copied or imitated. She was a member of the Darlington County Retired Teachers Association and the Antioch Garden Club. She was devoted to her family and the biggest Clemson Tiger fan around. She immensely enjoyed tailgating at Clemson football games for over 50 years. She wore her Clemson orange proudly. One of the most exciting moments in her life was when she received a phone call from Coach Tommy Bowden while she was in the hospital. She was known affectionately as "Mema."

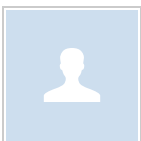
