Funeral services for Ebbie Noel Hoffman, 94, will be held at 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, May 9, 2007 at Middendorf Baptist Church. Mr. Hoffman, widower of Margaret Elizabeth "Bess" Threatt Hoffman of Pageland, died Monday, May 7, 2007. Born in Middendorf, SC, he was a son of the late Wilford Franklin and Christine Isabell "Tina" Brown Hoffman. He was a member of Middendorf Baptist Church, a graduate of McBee High School in 1930, and received his pharmacy degree from the University of South Carolina in 1933. He was a pharmacist for 69 years working first for Belamy Drug Co. in Wilmington, NC, then as owner of the Medical Arts Pharmacy in Lumberton, NC. During the 1980's he was the recipient of the Lions Foundation Award presented annually by the North Carolina Lions Clubs.
