Funeral services for Paul Edward "Ed" Northcutt, 84, will be held at 3:00 p.m. Friday, February 25, 2005 at Union United Methodist Church. The Rev. Roger Dodds will officiate with burial in the church cemetery directed by Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home.
