She was listed in Who's Who Among Students in American Colleges and Universities and was a recipient of the Turriss Fidelis Award, the highest honor bestowed by the college upon two graduating seniors at each commencement. She was a member of McRae Road Church of Christ in Camden, SC, and a homemaker for the majority of her adult life.

She is survived by her son, Wade Henderson Berkebile of Irmo, SC; daughter, Gayle Collins of New Bern, NC; several nieces and nephews.

In addition to her husband and parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, John Morris Henderson; sister, Mildred Henderson Cunningham; sister-in-law, Anna Mae Berkebile; brothers-in-law, Arthur Cunningham III, Evan Berkebile, Bob Berkebile; son-in-law, Wayne Collins.
