Edward Thomas Coker passed into eternal peace on January 30, 2018.

Ed was born July 25, 1968, in Hartsville, SC, the youngest son of the late Samuel

Pressly Coker, Jr. and Virginia King Smith Coker. He grew up in Hartsville, attended Thomas Hart Academy, and graduated from the University of South Carolina. Ed was an avid and accomplished tennis player for all of his life. He loved tennis, golf, and deep-sea fishing. He was the owner and President of S.P.

Coker Cotton Gin and Humphrey-Coker Seed Company, and the Darlington Oil

Mill. He was co-owner of Humphrey-Coker Machinery, Brown & Coker Realty, Hartsville Country Club, and Phoenix Gin Saws. He served on the Board of Mutual Savings and Loan, Hartsville, SC. On numerous occasions, spanning twenty-seven years, he was a contributing member and Board member of the Southeastern Cotton Ginners Association, Inc. Ed loved and was most proud of his

employees which are a part of his family.

Ed is survived by his mother, Virginia King Smith Coker of Hartsville, SC; brother, S. Pressly Coker, III of Hartsville, SC; sister, Celeste Coker Crisman (Mark) of Blacksburg, VA; nephew, S. Pressly Coker, IV; and nieces,

Katherine Lee Coker, and Kathleen Susan Coker. He was preceded in death by his brother, Andrew Lee Coker.

A graveside service will be conducted at 12 o'clock on Saturday, February 3, 2018, in Magnolia Cemetery with The Reverend Dr. Daniel N. Sansbury and The Reverend Sanders Read officiating.
