



Mr. Edwin "Ed" McNeely Guest III

September 23, 1945 - February 3, 2017

A celebration of the life of Mr. Edwin "Ed" McNeely Guest III, 71, will be held at 2 o'clock on Monday, February 6, 2017, at St. Luke United Methodist Church. The Rev. Gene Feagin will officiate, and the family will receive friends in the fellowship hall following the service. Mr. Guest died peacefully on Friday, February 3, 2017. Born in Charlotte, NC, he was the first born son of the late Edwin McNeely "Mac" Guest Jr. and Winston James Guest. He attended public schools in Laurinburg, NC and was an active member of First United Methodist Church. After receiving an Industrial Arts degree from N.C. State Univ, he taught school for a few years. During this time, he joined The National Guard. Following this he went to work for Fieldcrest Cannon Mills, where he was traffic manager for their truck fleet. This was a job he truly loved.

At the end of his career, he returned to Laurinburg to care for his elderly parents. It was during this time, that he and Anne rekindled their high school romance. They married in 2005 and settled in Hartsville. Ed was an extremely active member St. Luke United Methodist Church. He was in the chancel choir, played in the mountain dulcimer group and the chancel hand bells. He thoroughly enjoyed helping with Vacation Bible School and always liked to

donate several pints of his zucchini relish to be sold at the annual barbecue bake sale. Ed was always doing something at St. Luke. He once filled in as the church secretary for two months while the secretary's parents were ill, working five days a week. He also helped make school bags for UMCOR relief.

Ed LOVED Hartsville and everybody he talked to knew it. He couldn't say enough good things about the town and the people living there. He threw himself into helping others everywhere he went. He was one of Santa's helpers at the YMCA and Morrell's Nursing Home. He was very active in RENOFEST until his recent illness. He was active in too many areas to mention. Ed was everywhere and knew everybody. He loved people and loved making people happy.

Ed was a devoted father to his son, Neel and loving grandfather to Max. With his marriage to Anne, he gained another family who adored him: children Kevin, Molly and Patrick and granddaughters, Georgia and Charlotte. He always bragged on his family and how this "blended" family all got along with each other. They all loved Ed and will miss him every day. He was a good example of what a "good man" should be. He was kind, fair and affectionate. You knew when Ed loved you and he loved many.

Ed Guest will be missed by so many. God Bless you, Ed. May you rest in peace. Well done, my good and faithful servant.
