A private funeral service for the family of Elizabeth DuRant Brown, 94, who went to be with the Lord on May 12, 2020, will be held. She was the daughter of Lizzie Estelle DuRant and Robert Lee DuRant. She was the widow of John Henry Brown.

They lived most of their life on Jamestown Road in Lee County, where they sold vegetables from their acre gardens, year after year, and later in years they did woodcrafts and sold most of all to friends and Neighbors in Lee County and Sumter County.

Elizabeth worked during World War II at the shipyard in Savannah, GA, and later worked at Korn Industries in Sumter, SC. She attended Hickory Hill school and graduated from Ashwood School in 1944, after completing the 11th grade. The most important thing that happened in her life was when she excepted Jesus into her heart on December 16, 1971, at Saint Andrews Church of God under the Pastorship of The Rev. Philip Hoosier.

Elizabeth leaves behind a daughter, Judy B. McLeod, the widow of Wilbur McLeod; sons, Robert L. Brown, John Wayne Brown (Jenny), and Randy

Brown (Kay); 12 grandchildren; 25 great-grandchildren; two great-great-grandchildren.

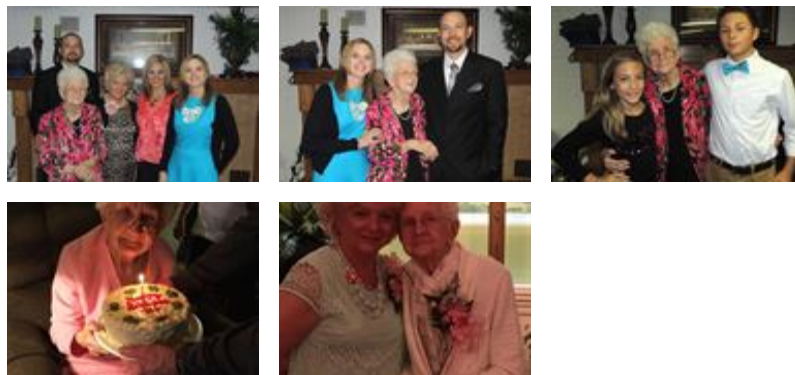
