Mr. Cook died Tuesday, October 28, 2014. Born in Hartsville, SC, he was a son of the late Judge Don Carl and Lucille Padgett Cook.

He was a graduate of the University of South Carolina and the University of South Carolina School of Law. He was a loyal Gamecock fan. He practiced law in Hartsville and was a member of the S.C. Bar Association. He was a member of Wesley United Methodist Church, served in the S.C. House of Representatives, was a member of the Hartsville Civitans Club, and he served his country in the U.S. Navy during World World II.
