



Mr. Frank Joseph Prehoda

May 16, 1928 - March 4, 2022

It is with deep sorrow that the Prehoda family announces the death of their beloved father, Frank Joseph Prehoda, 93, of Inman, South Carolina.

Mr. Prehoda, the widower of his beloved wife, Robin Hicks Prehoda, passed away peacefully on Friday, March 4, 2022.

A visitation to honor and celebrate his life will be held from 2:00 until 4:00 pm on Saturday, March 19, 2022, at Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home. A private family graveside service will follow. Frank was born on May 16, 1928, in Wiggins, Mississippi, to the late Blase Joseph Prehoda and Josephine Kriss Prehoda. After attending Clemson University, he transferred and graduated from The Georgia Institute of Technology in 1954 with honors. Upon graduating, he worked for the Esso Standard Oil Company in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. After several years, he and his family moved to Hartsville, South Carolina and he worked in various divisions for the Sonoco Products Company. He retired in 1990 after 30 years and he often joked in his later years that he was retired longer than he

worked.

While living in Hartsville and raising his family, Mr. Prehoda was also active in the community. He was a long-time member of First Baptist Church in Hartsville. He was a long-time member of the Hartsville Kiwanis Club and had the distinguished honor of serving as Club President twice.

After retirement, he became a Master Gardener. Anyone driving around Hartsville can see the beauty from his hard work and great efforts working with Trees for Tomorrow. Not only did he assist in the planting of many trees, but he also designed and built the machine that watered them. He also volunteered his time and efforts to help improve Kalmia Gardens. He was an avid golfer and enjoyed playing for many years at the Hartsville Country Club.

He is survived by his two daughters, Christi Prehoda Fowler (Bruce) of Chesnee, South Carolina, and Ann Prehoda Cunningham (Shawn) of Lyman, South Carolina; sister, Barbara Mahaffey of Georgetown, South Carolina; grandchildren, Robert Michael Fowler (Lisa) of Inman, South Carolina, Victoria Ann Simmons (Trey) of Charleston, South Carolina; his soon to be great-grandchild, "Little Nugget" of Charleston, South Carolina. In addition to his beloved wife and his parents, he was preceded in death by his son, Robert Michael Prehoda of Conway, South Carolina.

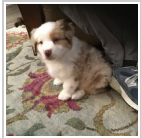
