



Mr. Frank Bernard Winslow Jr.

November 1, 1927 - September 9, 2015

Funeral services for Francis "Frank" Bernard Winslow, 87, will be held at 1:00 pm Tuesday, September 15, 2015 at First Presbyterian Church.

The Rev. Dr. Dan Sansbury will officiate with burial in Magnolia Cemetery. The family will receive friends from 5:00 pm until 7:00 pm on Monday at Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home.

Mr. Winslow died Wednesday, September 9, 2015. Born in Emporium, PA, he was a son of the late Francis Bernard and Grace Gontero Winslow.

After graduating from high school, Frank enlisted in the U. S. Army, trained at Virginia Military Institute, and was part of the first occupying force in Tokyo.

Following World War II, he graduated from Penn State University with a B. S. in Chemistry. He worked for a paper mill in Johnsonburg where he met his wife, Betty. After stops in Fort Madison, IA and Natchez, MS, Frank and Betty moved in 1969 to Hartsville, SC where he worked for 25 years in the Environmental Control department at Sonoco Products Company. In 2006, Frank was honored with a Lifetime Achievement Award from Penn State University. The award recognized both his work in the field of industrial waste treatment and his many years of work in his church and community. At his church, First Presbyterian, Frank served as a deacon, elder and taught the men's Sunday school class.

Surviving are his daughter, Rebecca (Arthur) Lincoln of Myrtle Beach, SC; sisters, Jean Winslow of Emporium, PA, Katherine Newton of N. Tonowanda, NY; brother, Jim Winslow of Chichester, NH; grandchildren, Jamie Lujan of
