Funeral services for Murry Franklin “Frankie” Odom, 64, will be held at 3:00 p.m. Sunday, February 4, 2007 at Lakeview Baptist Church. The Rev. Dr. Charles Boswell and the Rev. Mr. Odom died Friday, February 2, 2007. Born in Hartsville, SC, he was a son of the late Murry T. and Edith McInville Odom. He was a member of Lakeview Baptist Church and a former deacon and music director at Fourth Street Baptist Church. He was retired from Sonoco Products Company with 43 years of service and was responsible, along with Don Sudlow, for the first personal computer at Sonoco. He was owner of Frankie Odom's Computer Tax Service for 37 years, an announcer for Hartsville High football for over 20 years, a past president and member of WOW, a longtime treasurer for Lakeview Club, and a member of the Old Timers Club. He was known for his entertainment as a magician and was a member of the Society of American Magicians, International Brotherhood of Magicians, and United Magicians Association, Surviving are his wife, Joan Massey Odom of Hartsville, SC; daughter, Kim Odom of Hartsville, SC; brothers and sister-in-law, George Odom of Calhoun, GA, A.
