November 24, 1922 - November 18, 2005

Funeral services for George Thomas Balfour, 82, will be held at 11:00 a.m. Tuesday, November 22, 2005 at St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church. Fr. Michael Ridgill will officiate with burial in Magnolia Cemetery directed by Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home. Mr. Balfour, widower of Betty Balfour, died Friday, November 18, 2005. Born in Hyde Park, MA, he was a son of the late James Walter and Hattie Whynott Balfour. He was a member of St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church and a Master Mason in East Hampton, CT. He was a U. S. Navy and U. S. Coast Guard veteran, serving in World War II and the Korean Conflict.

Surviving are his son, Gary T. Balfour of Arusha, Tanzania; daughter and son-in-law, Jean B. and Elias Mixon of Hartsville, SC; sister, Olive Coutier of Billerica, MA; grandchildren and spouse, Leslie Thomas and Donna Mixon of Beaufort, SC, Scott Andrew Mixon of Hartsville, SC; 2 great-grandchildren.
