



## Glenn Wallace

November 15, 1944 - December 2, 2006

Graveside services for Glenn Eugene Wallace, Sr. 62, will be held at 11 a.m., Tuesday, December 5th, 2006, at Magnolia Cemetery in Hartsville, South Carolina. Jim Giddens, Senior Minister at the Skidaway Island United Methodist Church in Savannah, Georgia, will officiate; Brown-Pennington Atkins is in charge. Mr. Wallace died on Saturday, December 2nd at his home in Savannah, Georgia. Born in Cheraw, South Carolina, he was the son of Robert T. Wallace and the late Eleanor B. Wallace of Hartsville. With his father, Mr. Wallace opened Robert Wallace and Son, which they operated together for over 35 years. In 2003, Mr. Wallace moved to Savannah, Georgia, and joined the Savannah College of Art and Design as the Executive Director for Physical Resources. Mr. Wallace was dedicated to his church, family and his many friends in both Savannah and Hartsville.

Surviving are his wife, Roberta Skinner Wallace of Savannah; his father, Robert T. Wallace of Hartsville; sisters and brothers-in-law, Elizabeth and

Ronald Amerson of Hartsville and Eleanor and William Hurtes of Charleston, South Carolina; daughter, Christen Janine Wallace of Savannah; son and daughter-in-law, Glenn E. Wallace, Jr. and Paula S. Wallace of Savannah; and two grandchildren, Madison Lee Wallace and Glenn E. Wallace III, both of Savannah.
