Most of all she always made us laugh and brought great joy to our lives with her unique expressions and quick-witted responses. We are left with precious memories.

She loved to read, sew and watch the news. She made beautiful hand embroidered and stitched quilts, pillowcases, and dish towels. Her hands were always busy, caring for others, cleaning, sewing, and working in her yards. She loved to plant flowers and watch them grow. She nurtured them just like she did everyone else.

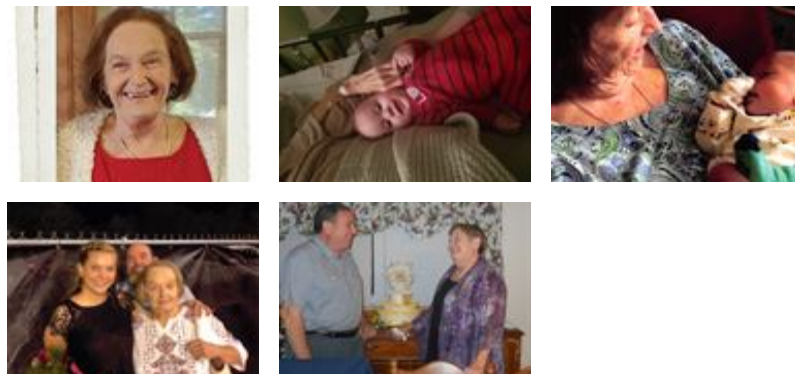

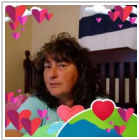
