



## Mrs. Hallie Patricia "Pat" Valentine Atkinson

It is with deep sorrow that the Atkinson family announces the death of their beloved mother, Mrs. Hallie Patricia "Pat" Valentine Atkinson, 89.

Mrs. Atkinson, the widow of Ray E. Atkinson, entered her heavenly home on February 25, 2026. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.

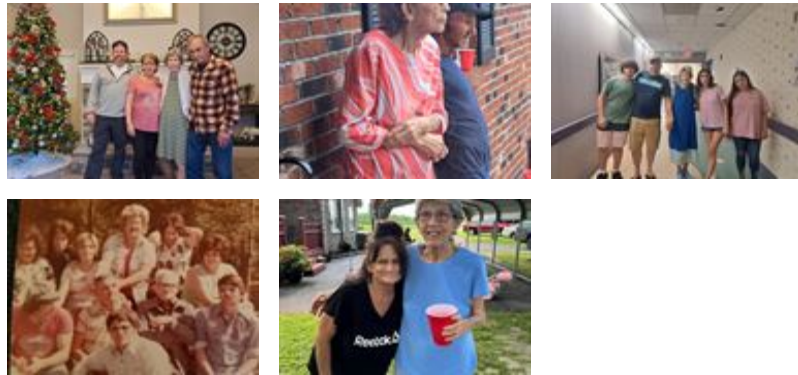
