After Helen graduated from Toccoa High School, she began her career at The Bank of Toccoa, moving later to West Palm Beach, FL where she worked at the Atlantic Bank. In 1972 Jack and Helen moved to Hartsville, SC where she continued her banking career with the Bank of Hartsville. Later she changed her career and worked as office manager for Dr. William Laney and Dr. Dargan Flowers. After retiring they traveled to many states. In 2008 they made a transition to The Manor Retirement Home in Florence, SC.

She is survived by her sister, Katherine Rumsey; brothers, Jerry (Gaye) Farmer and Lenox Farmer; several nieces and nephews; and special friends, Jimmy and Deena Shelley. In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her husband, Jack, and her brother, Kenneth.
