



## Mr. Herbert Albert Roos

June 23, 1929 - June 12, 2026

Herbert Albert Roos, husband of Elizabeth Thomas Roos, died peacefully on Friday, June 12, 2026, at his residence. He was 96 years old.

Mr. Roos entered into rest on Friday, June 12, 2026. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.

A celebration of his life will be held at 11 o'clock on Friday, June 19, 2026, at St. Luke Methodist Church with The Rev. Todd Davis officiating. A reception will be held immediately following the service. A private family entombment will be held in the church columbarium.

In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made in his honor to St. Luke Methodist Church or Hartsville Habitat for Humanity.

Mr. Roos was born on Sunday, June 23, 1929, in Philadelphia, PA. He is the son of the late Albert G. Roos and the late Erna Ida Busse Roos. He graduated from Mastbaum Vocational Technical High School. He entered the Navy's Construction Battalion after high school and was stationed in Japan. Upon honorable discharge, he applied to Penn State University, where he majored in architecture and design. He taught school at Bucks County Technical High School in Levittown, PA.

Mr. Roos was a project planner with the Public Housing Administration in Atlanta, GA. During his tenure there, he had a temporary assignment in Nigeria. Following that, he was transferred to the US Agency for International Development, where he worked on developing low-cost housing in Central and South America. Further employment was with Caltex Oil Company in Indonesia, Aramco in Saudi Arabia, and Texaco Oil Company in Kuwait.

In retirement, he moved to Hartsville, SC, with his wife of seventy years. There, he was active in Habitat for Humanity and in his church, St. Luke United Methodist Church. He was a member of the Hartsville Kiwanis Club and was a Master Mason in the Masonic Lodge in Atlanta, GA. He received several awards from the community.

He is survived by his loving wife, Elizabeth Thomas Roos; two sons, Thomas A. Roos of Phoenix, AZ, and Steven H. Roos (Kimberly) of Hartsville, SC; three grandchildren, Thomas Wesley Roos, Alexander Lawrence Roos, and Kathryn Anne Roos.
