May 1, 1914 - June 22, 2010

Graveside services for Hugh Eldridge Gibson, 96, will be held at 3:00 p.m. Friday, June 25, 2010 at Magnolia Cemetery. The Rev. Dr. Charles Roberts will officiate and Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home is serving the family. The family will receive friends Thursday, June 24, 2010 from 5-7 p.m. at the funeral home. Mr. Gibson, widower of Joan Teucher Gibson, died Tuesday, June 22, 2010. Born in Clarendon Co., SC, he was a son of the late John Rollins and Emily Stone Gibson. He was a member of the First Baptist Church, the Hartsville Masonic Lodge #173, York Rite, and the Omar Shrine. He served his country during WWII as a radio operator in the 1st Army, 5th Corps, 56th Signal Battalion. He was a co-owner and operator, along with his late wife, of Gibson's IGA Foodliner for over 25 years. He was a devoted husband, loving father, grandfather, and was active in the community.
