



## Hugh Gerard Moren, Jr.

April 3, 1929 - February 4, 2009

Hugh Gerard Moren, Jr, age 79, died on the morning of February 4, 2009, following a courageous battle against cancer. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 p.m. Saturday, February 7, 2009 at St. Luke United Methodist Church with burial in Magnolia Cemetery. Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home is serving the family. The family will receive friends Friday from 6-8 p.m. at the funeral home.
