Mrs. Hylda Inabinet Bass, widow of Robert "Bob" King Bass, Sr. died Monday, October 27, 2008 at McLeod Regional Medical Center, Florence, S.C.

Mrs. Bass was born April 14, 1927 in Calhoun County. She was the daughter of the late Jimmie Franklin Inabinet and the late Lillie Wannamaker Inabinet. She was a graduate of St. Matthews High School and Coker College, class of 1948, and was a retired teacher from the Darlington County Schools. She was a charter member of St. Luke United Methodist Church, a longtime member of the Hallie Byrd Circle and XYZ, and treasurer of UMW for many years. Mrs. Bass faithfully volunteered for the local chapter of the American Red Cross. Surviving are her two children Robert King Bass, Jr. of Hartsville and Elizabeth "Beth" Wannamaker Bass of Atlanta, Ga., brother David Allen Inabinet and sister-in-law Lilyanne Peterkin Inabinet also of Hartsville, brother James Ray Inabinet of Columbia, cousins, nieces, nephews and many special friends.
