



## Mr. James Herring Jr.

It is with deep sorrow that the Herring family announces the death of Mr. James "Jim" Herring, 58.

Mr. Herring entered into rest on Monday, March 4, 2024. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.

A funeral service to honor his life will be held at 3 o'clock on Friday, March 8, 2024, at First Presbyterian Church in Hartsville, South Carolina, with The Rev. Ashley L. Cheek officiating.
