Mr. Howle died Wednesday, July 13, 2011. Born in the Byrdtown Community of Darlington County, SC, he was the son of the late Albert Joye and Alma Smith Howle. He was a charter member of Morton Presbyterian Church, where he served as an elder and treasurer. He served in the U.S. Navy on the USS Dyess during World War II and retired as a supervisor with 44 years of service from Sonoco Products Company. He also enjoyed farming and raising beef cattle.
