



Mr. James Leroy Kinsley

February 2, 1958 - July 3, 2020

A graveside funeral service for Mr. James Leroy Kinsley, 62, will be held at 11:00 am on Tuesday, July 7, 2020 in Magnolia Cemetery. The Rev. Steve Winburn will officiate.

Mr. Kinsley died peacefully on Friday, July 3, 2020. Born in Frankfurt, Germany, he was a son of the late Melvin George Kinsley and Esther Emma Jorgensen Kinsley. He graduated from Eisenhower High School, Lawton, OK, and served six years in the U. S. Marine Corps. He was in law enforcement for seven years, was employed with Interstate Brands, and was retired from Pepsi. He was a retired member of the Hartsville Rescue Squad and was a member of the Dive Team. He enjoyed being involved with Ducks Unlimited for many years and had an ongoing relationship with his Harley, "Duece."

Surviving are his wife of 37 years, Deborah "Debbie" L. Kinsley; daughter, Cameren Michelle Kinsley; grandson, Baylor Cruz Herhily.

He was preceded in death by his daughter, Sutton Marie Kinsley; siblings, Sherry Griggs, Karen Kinsley, Carol Logan, Melvin Kinsley Jr., Robert Kinsley.

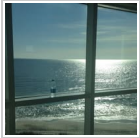
