



## Rev. James Zinnermon Smith Sr.

May 12, 1947 - May 15, 2025

It is with deep sorrow that Mrs. Olivia Melton Smith and her family announce the death of her beloved husband, Rev. James Zinnermon Smith, Sr., 78.

Rev. Smith entered into rest on Thursday, May 15, 2025. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.

A funeral service to honor his life will be held at 2 o'clock on Sunday, May 18, 2025, in Tabernacle Methodist Church. The Rev. Jimmy was ordained as a minister on March 18, 1984. He pastored several churches. For the past three years, he has been serving as Pastor for the Children's Baptist Church in Patrick, SC. Jimmy had a radio ministry for twenty-five years and had a thirty-five-year nursing home ministry.

He also worked for the former VesiTech Plant in Bethune, SC, for forty years. For leisure, he enjoyed bird watching, as well as his boxing and Gunsmoke.

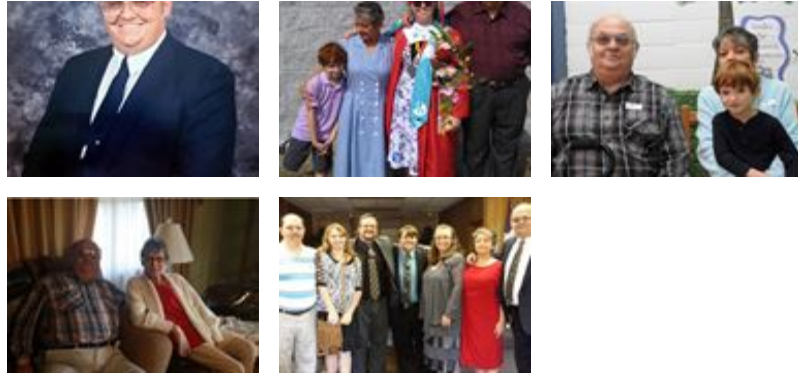

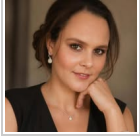
