



Mrs. Jane Snipes Easterling

June 2, 1924 - March 28, 2016

Funeral services for Mrs. Jane Snipes Easterling, 91, who died on Monday, March 28, 2016, will be held at 2 o'clock on Thursday, March 31, 2016 in First Baptist Church. The Rev. Dr. Aubrey Floyd will officiate with a burial to follow in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends on Wednesday, March 30, 2016 from 4:00 until 6:00 pm at Mrs. Easterling's residence, 2149 Patrick Highway, Hartsville, SC. Mrs. Easterling, widow of Jesse Thomas Easterling, was born on June 2, 1924, a daughter of the late Elbert and Irene Kelley Snipes. Jane retired from Sonoco Products Company in 1992 with 50 Years of Service. During her tenure at Sonoco, Jane worked in Corporate Communicates as Editor of the Sonoco News. She also worked heavily with the Old Timer's Group and United Way. In 1996, she was awarded the Distinguished "Super Volunteer Award" by United Way.

During her years with Sonoco, Jane volunteered in several capacities. She was instrumental in the founding of Thomas Hart Academy, where she served on the Board of Directors for several years.

Mrs. Easterling was an active member of First Baptist Church. She

volunteered heavily with First Baptist Church, Soup Kitchen and Food Bank in Hartsville. Jane was a dedicated volunteer with the Red Cross for many years, and was awarded the Red Cross “Meritorious Volunteer Leadership” Award in 1996. She also served on the Red Cross State Board of Directors.

She is survived by three sons: Larry (Jennie) Easterling; Kim (Holly) Easterling; and Tod (Bene) Easterling, all of Hartsville. She leaves nine grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren. She is also survived by Sue Walters, Buzzie Snipes and Fred Snipes of Hartsville, SC; and Ronnie Snipes of Debarry, FL.
