December 18, 1967 - January 7, 2012

Jason M. Dunn, 44, passed away on Saturday, January 7, 2012. He was born in Clarksville, TN, on December 18, 1967. After living in Kentucky and Ohio for several years as a child, he moved to Hartsville with his family where he spent most of his youth and adult life. He was the son of Nancy Payne Dunn and the late Martin T. Dunn of Hartsville. He was a 1986 graduate of Hartsville High School, where he was a member of the track team. After attending Francis Marion University, he served his country in the U. S. Army where he was stationed in South Korea. After his stint in the Army, he was a member of the National Guard unit in Hartsville. He was employed as a machinist at Industrial Products & Services Inc in Hartsville, where he worked for over a decade. Jason was a gentle, caring soul, whose interests included cooking, movies, music, reading, and watching the Pittsburgh Steelers play football. He is survived by his mother, Nancy P. Dunn (Randy Britt); his two loving siblings, brother, Matthew of Hartsville; and sister, Marla Stout of Kingsport, TN. Mr. Dunn was the proud uncle of his nephew, Turner Stout of Kingsport, TN. He is also survived by his maternal grandmother, Dorothy Payne of Clarksville, TN. In addition, Mr. Dunn leaves behind many aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends, all of whom he loved dearly.
