



Mr. J.E. Mozingo Jr.

Funeral services for Johnnie Edward Mozingo, Jr., 83, will be held at 11:00 a.m. Saturday, August 4, 2012 at Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church. The Rev. Valerie Mireb and The Rev. Mr. Mozingo died Thursday, August 2, 2012. Born in Darlington County, SC, he was a son of the late Johnnie Edward and Lois Campbell Mozingo. He was a lifetime member of Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church and served on most committees, including chairman of the board of trustees. He also served on the Darlington County School Board of Trustees for twelve years. He served his country during the Korean War in the United States Army. He was instrumental in organizing the Lamar Men's Prayer Breakfast as a charter member, and was a life-time farmer and owner of Planter's Tobacco Warehouse in Darlington, SC.
